





Figure 1. Typical Output Characteristics




Figure 2. Typical Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. $R_{DS(\text{ON})}$ vs. Drain Current




Figure 4. Body Diode Characteristics




Figure 5. Normalized BV_{DSS} vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 7. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 8. Normalized $R_{DS(ON)}$ vs. T_J





Figure 9. Safe Operation Area
